
HOW TO APPLY?

Via Online Application

- 1. Apply online via your ImmiAccount here: https://online.immi.gov.au/lusc/login
 - a. Note: You need an ImmiAccount to apply for the visa.
 - b. If you do not have one, you can register for one here: https://online.immi.gov.au/lusc/register
- 2. Online payment by MasterCard, VISA, American Express, Diners Club, JCB, or PayPal
- *All visitors to Australia must have a valid visa to travel to and enter Australia (other than New Zealand passport holders who will normally be granted a Special Category visa on arrival, provided they meet the health and character requirements; and permanent residents of Norfolk Island who may be granted a Permanent Resident of Norfolk Island visa on arrival).
